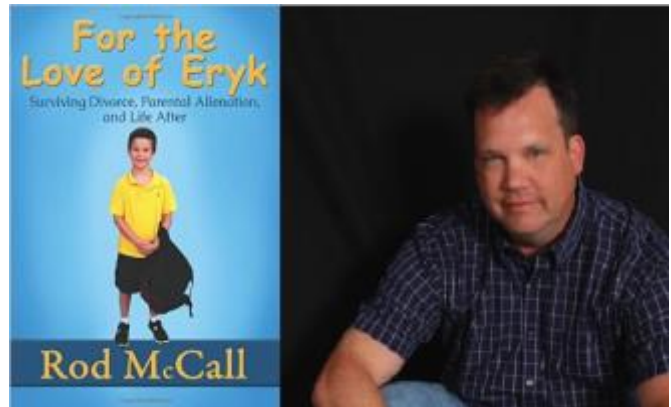

In 2011, our presenter Rod McCall was awarded FULL custody of his son Eryk by a jury vote. Tragically, Rod's ex-wife then murdered 7-year old Eryk and committed suicide. Rod wrote the book, "For the Love of Eryk" and will share his story and also educate and inspire us with ways to stop this painful form of child abuse.

Parental alienation is a form of child abuse. It is the result of a parent psychologically brain washing their child into showing unwarranted fear, disrespect and hostility towards their other parent. These children victims often suffer social adjustment challenges and face difficulty re-engaging with the needed & desired love of the targeted parent.

Parental alienation is very prevalent, with 6% of all parents reported severe alienation. This is growing health crisis and hidden epidemic, out of sight because the children have no physical signs of abuse and they don't even know they are being abused.
